

Preston Pugh is an experienced U.S. litigation and compliance lawyer at Pugh, Jones & Johnson, P.C. in both Chicago and New York. Formerly an Assistant U.S. Attorney, Senior Investigations Counsel at the General Electric Company, and partner at two AmLaw 100 law firms, today he devotes most of his time to representing clients in highly regulated industries, including healthcare, defense, finance and air transportation.
